



## **A TOWN HALL MEETING IN NEW YORK CITY IN COMMEMORATION OF FASCIST ITALY'S WAR CRIMES AGAINST ETHIOPIA**

As part of an international public event scheduled in major cities throughout the world, a historic town hall meeting will be held in New York City on Saturday, March 1, 2014, in remembrance of the three-day Fascist massacre of 30,000 Ethiopians in Addis Ababa in February of 1937, as well as other Fascist war crimes committed against Ethiopia during the infamous Italian invasion of 1935 -1941.

- Destruction of more than 2,000 churches and over 525,000 homes
- Irreparable environmental devastation.
