The National COVID-19 Taskforce in Ethiopia is working hard to slow and prevent the spread of the disease, expanding testing, and provide medical treatment to those that are positive. In developing countries like Ethiopia, there are structural challenges to overcome. The recent unrest has not helped. Following a worldwide call for action and the call by The Permanent Mission of Ethiopia to the United Nations, the NY Tri-State Ethiopia COVID-19 Relief Fund Taskforce was formed and will launch Wegen Le Wegen on Monday, July 27 at 5pm on facebook live.

ECMAA is working closely with representatives of the tri-state Ethiopian community on the taskforce to mobilize financial relief for Ethiopia. All funds will be used for COVID-19 related expenses.
